Belize City also known as the Old Capital is rich with colonial history. It's one of the first settlement established in Belize, formerly known as the "British Honduras," by the British. While in Belize City, you can go shopping, visit the old colonial Government House (House of Culture), or the Museum. From Belize City, you can take a water taxi to Caye Caulker or San Pedro or book a tour to anywhere in Belize.

Things to do:

- ❖ *Althun Ha Mayan Temple* - Hike to the top of the tallest temple and enjoy a panoramic view of the entire site, which includes some thirteen temples and residential structures.
- ❖ *Xunantunich Mayan Temple* - Built by the Mayans on a hill that overlooks the Mopan River. Hike to the top and experience an amazing view and look across the border into Guatemala.
- ❖ *Belize Zoo* - The natural environment of Belize and the home for over 125 animals of 48 species.
