



ST HERMANS CAVE AND THE INLAND BLUE HOLE (Dual site tour)

- Located just a few hundred yards off the Humming Bird Highway, Cayo District 12 miles south of Belmopan.
- Departs from Belize City or Belize International Airport. Please contact us for departures from other locations.
- Duration: 3hrs

The main entrance to the St. Hermans cave is clearly marked; it's about 180 feet wide with stone cut stairs believed to have been built by the Mayans. The trail in the cave narrows to about 60 feet and is marked for your safety. Once inside the cave you will see crystal clear water from an underground river that runs through the cave. You will see amazing rock formations and

get a good feel for the Mayan Underworld. As you explore deeper into the cave, the trail gets a bit more rugged. Of course you may turn around and head back whenever you have enough.

The Inland Blue Hole is located in the same (Blue Hole National Park) park as St Herman's cave. You can take a scenic walk from St Herman's cave through the rainforest to the Inland Blue Hole. The Inland Blue Hole was formed by a sunken underground river; it's about 25 feet deep and is perfect for a refreshing dip. The Blue Hole National Park is great place for a picnic, nature trail hikes, and bird watching.

Wear comfortable footwear; no flip flops please. **DON'T FORGET TO BRING YOUR CAMERA!!!**
